American Initiative for Health and Wellness in Africa (AIHWA) is a multinational non-profit (501) (c)3 organization established with headquarters in Colorado, USA and registered in Nigeria. AIHWA is a non-profit organization with a field office presence in Abuja, Nigeria striving to improve healthcare in Nigeria through its special areas of interest:

- Medical Education: The training of local healthcare providers as well as planning for future international conferences focusing on integrated healthcare and rehabilitation.
- 2) Medical Missions: Our missions bring internationally trained physicians to Nigeria for both short and long-term quality care. Since it's commencement in Nigeria one year ago, our program has impacted nearly four thousand lives.
- 3) Patient Prisoner Program: This refers to patients who are detained within hospitals due to inability to pay their medical bills. AIHWA partners with several hospitals to provide financial support and advocate for the release of these patients.
- 4) Counseling/Mental Health: The stigma surrounding mental illness prevents families and those suffering from these illnesses from accessing the necessary mental health counseling and psychiatric interventions.


 AIWHA plans to partner with spiritual

leaders who are often the first to recognize mental health illness. Many people suffering from mental illness often consult spiritual leaders for fear of being possessed by demons. It is our hope that with this partnership, spiritual leaders will have the ability to refer people for appropriate mental health evaluations prior to engaging in exorcisms or other interventions. One of AIHWA's goals is the development and establishment of the AIHWA HOPE CENTER.

This dream is driven by the need to bring our integrated healthcare and rehabilitation programs under one facility. In addition to medical services, this center will serve as a research institute for the advancement of mental health and wellness. The HOPE CENTER, which is estimated to cost 3.6 million dollars, will be comprised of a medical, counseling, and rehabilitation programs, as well as an integrated health research institute, fitness center, restaurant, organic vegetable gardens, conference hall, and at least 20 guest rooms for short-term residence.

Pre-registration began the week before the medical mission. The response to the free surgical clinic was incredible, with all spots taken in the first two days. AlHWA then opened registration up to all. Staff from the Nigerian volunteers and St. Mary's Hospital staff registered over 1,300 people which kept increasing everyday as people received the news of the mission.

COUNSELING AT THE MEDICAL MISSION



70% of the patients wanted their eyes checked for disease or corrective lenses. While AIHWA was not able to provide the corrective lenses on the spot, refraction was done on each patient and prescriptions for the lenses were provided and sent to manufacturers in the US. AIHWA will deliver the corrective lenses to 177 patients in December 2018.


Our glass products increase the comfort of the cabin area for the driver and passenger by reflecting the hot energy away from the glass and retaining cold energy in the cabin of the bus.


